PURPOSE

This COVID-19 Line of Duty Death Policy ("Policy) outlines the process to apply for payment of a widow's annuity and death benefits to eligible beneficiaries as a result of a deceased firefighter's exposure to and contraction of COVID-19 pursuant to Sections 6-140 and 150 of the Illinois Pension Code ("Pension Code") [40 ILCS 5/6-140; 40 ILCS 5/6-150; Public Act 101-0633]. An application for line of duty death benefits as a result of a deceased firefighter's exposure to and contraction of COVID-19 under Sections 6-140 and 150 shall be adjudicated in accordance with the Pension Code and this Policy.

DEFINITIONS

For the purposes of this Policy, the term "COVID-19" refers to the novel coronavirus disease as defined by the Center for Disease Control. The term "Board" refers to the Board of Trustees of the Firemen's Annuity and Benefit Fund of Chicago (the "Fund"). The term "Hearing" refers to the proceedings before the Board in its consideration of an applicant's application for line of duty death benefits as a result of a deceased firefighter's exposure to and contraction of COVID-19 under Sections 6-140 and 6-150 of the Pension Code.

ELIGIBILITY FOR LINE OF DUTY DEATH BENEFITS

Line of Duty Death—Widow's Annuity Benefits & Death Benefit

Sections 6-140 and 6-150 of the Pension Code provide that the death of any fireman <u>as a result of the</u> <u>exposure to and contraction of COVID-19</u> shall be rebuttably presumed to have been contracted while in the performance of an act or acts of duty and the fireman shall be rebuttably presumed to have been fatally injured while in active service.

Such presumption shall only apply to a fireman who was exposed to and contracted COVID-19 on or after March 9, 2020 and on or before December 31, 2020. The date of contraction is either the date that the fireman was diagnosed with COVID-19 or was unable to work due to symptoms that were later diagnosed as COVID-19, whichever occurred first.

In determining whether a fireman's death was the result of the exposure and contraction of COVID-19 for purposes of a widow's annuity, the widow of the deceased fireman has the burden of proving that the firefighter <u>had either (i) a confirmed positive laboratory test for COVID-19 or COVID-19</u> antibodies or (ii) a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19 from a licensed medical professional.

In determining whether a fireman's death was the result of the exposure and contraction of COVID-19 for purposes of a death benefit under Section 6-150 of the Pension Code, the beneficiary or beneficiaries nominated by the fireman by written direction filed with the Board have the burden of providing that the firefighter <u>had either (i) a confirmed positive laboratory test for COVID-19 or COVID-19 antibodies</u> or (ii) a confirmed diagnosis of COVID-19 from a licensed medical professional.

For the avoidance of doubt, any documentation submitted by the widow or beneficiary confirming a positive diagnosis for COVID-19 or positive laboratory test for COVID-19 or its antibodies must also confirm that such test or diagnosis occurred on or after March 9, 2020 and on or before December 31, 2020.

In no event shall a widow or beneficiary be eligible for benefits under this Policy if the deceased fireman was on a leave of absence from his or her employment or otherwise not required to report for duty for a period of 14 or more consecutive days immediately prior to the date of contraction of COVID-19.

THE APPLICATION PROCESS AND HEARING BEFORE THE BOARD

Pre-Hearing Procedural Requirements

A widow or beneficiary seeking benefits under this Policy may file with the Board an application for benefits pursuant to the requirements of the Pension Code. Generally, an application shall be submitted to the Board upon an application form designated by the Board for the benefit sought, shall be sworn to under oath and shall contain such detail as to substantially apprise the Board of the date, place, time and specific facts with respect to the claimed benefit and the circumstances giving rise to same.

The following additional documents are required to accompany an application for line of duty death benefits as a result of a deceased firefighter's exposure to and contraction of COVID-19: (i) a certified copy of the deceased firefighter's death certificate; (ii) proof of marriage (if applicable); (iii) all laboratory tests undertaken by the deceased firefighter for COVID-19 or COVID-19 antibodies; (iv) all medical documentation involving the deceased firefighter and his or her COVID-19 diagnosis; (v) work history documentation from the Chicago Fire Department; (vi) lay-up information involving the time-period relating to the COVID-19 diagnosis, if applicable, from the Chicago Fire Department; and (vi) any other documentation relevant to the applicant's burden of proof pursuant to Sections 6-140 and 6-150 and this Policy.

Please note that the Fund may request additional documentation, if necessary, to substantiate such exposure to and contraction of COVID-19.

The Board Hearing

Upon the filing of an application with the Fund, the Board will schedule a hearing date upon which the applicant's application for line of duty death benefits as the result of the exposure to and contraction of COVID-19 shall be considered. It is the policy of the Board that hearings upon applications be promptly conducted; provided, however, that good cause shown by the applicant or Fund staff may result in a continuance of the scheduled hearing date.

At any time, the Board may require the appearance of witnesses, the production of evidence, or a written submission to help clarify an issue in connection with the Hearing.

The Board shall have full authority to control the procedure of all Hearings, including but not limited

to: (i) to arrange for medical opinions; (ii) to employ any such agents or professionals as they shall deem necessary or proper in carrying out their duties; (iii) to move to executive session pursuant to the requirements of the Illinois Open Meetings Act; (iv) to exclude witnesses; (v) to protect the privacy of applicants; (vi) to rule upon all motions and objections; (vii) to admit or exclude testimony or other evidence; and (viii) to make any other necessary decisions and orders. The Board shall not be bound by the strict rules of evidence applicable in courts of law or equity.

The Hearing shall be conducted in accordance with the Board's "Procedures Governing Applications for Administrative Hearings", a copy of which may be requested from the Fund's office or located on the Fund's website. The Hearing shall be transcribed by a Board appointed reporter. Upon completion of the Hearing, a full record of said hearing, including all documentary and medical evidence submitted shall be submitted to each member of the Board for review and consideration.

FINAL ADMINISTRATIVE DECISION

Following the Hearing on an application for line of duty death benefits as a result of a deceased firefighter's exposure to and contraction of COVID-19, the Board shall consider the application and render a final administrative decision in writing that shall be issued to the applicant within ninety (90) days from the Hearing date; provided, however, that the Board may issue a final administrative decision following ninety (90) days in the event of extraordinary circumstances. The Board's decision shall be sent in the U.S. Mail, certified or registered, return receipt requested, to the applicant's last known address on file at the office of the Board.

CONFLICTS

Any conflict between the statutory provisions of the Pension Code and this Policy shall be resolved by the application of the statutory provisions of the Pension Code. For the avoidance of doubt, the Hearing and any subsequent appeal shall be governed by the Administrative Review Act, 735 ILCS 5/3-101, *et seq.*

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

Representation by Counsel

At all times from the date of the filing of applicant's application, throughout the Hearing process and thereafter, the Board will be represented by Counsel.

If an applicant chooses to be represented by Counsel at any stage of the proceedings before the Board, such Counsel must file an attorney appearance form with the Board. Upon the filing of an attorney appearance form, all applicant communications thereafter shall be through the contact information for the identified Counsel for the applicant.

Applicant's Burden

The applicant has the burden of proving by a preponderance of the evidence his or her right to the benefits outlined in this Policy.
